

Katherine High School Uniform policy

All students at Katherine High School are required to wear the mandatory School uniform at all times, except on specially nominated free dress days.

The mandatory School uniform consists of:

Middle Years

Katherine High School shirt Black shorts (shorts must be an appropriate length as determined by the School) Closed in shoes (e.g. sneakers/trainers)

Senior Years

Katherine High School shirt

Black or denim shorts (shorts must be an appropriate length as determined by the School)

Closed in shoes (e.g. sneakers/trainers)

Year 12 Jersey/Polo Shirt

For all year levels, leggings are not to be worn at any time.

Body Jewellery

Body piercings will be assessed according to their Work, Health and Safety risk.

Physical Education Classes

Students will need to bring a change of clothes for PE classes. Appropriate changing and showering facilities are available at School.

Katherine High School recommends the SunSmart Policy. Students are encouraged to wear hats whenever out in the sun.

Exceptions to the Uniform:

Black tracksuit pants or black denim jeans may be worn in the Dry Season School Sport and Rivers Shirts may be worn on Thursdays Clontarf or STARS shirts can be worn in place of the School shirt

Breach of Policy

As per current process, if students do not follow the School's Uniform requirements, they may be asked to go home and change. Persistent breaches of the Uniform Policy may result in a student being suspended.
